

Provider Notes for Parent Conference Form: 4- Success Assessment Review

DIAL-3 Scoring Information:

- ❖ After scoring the Dial-3 refer to the ages at the top of the record form (under scaled score). If the child is 3.00-3.11 place a pencil vertically under the 3 yrs. section (under scaled score 1). If child is 4.0-4.11 place pencil vertically under 4 yrs. (under scaled score 2). If child is 5.0-5.11 place pencil vertically under 5 yrs. (under scaled score 3).
- ❖ Any items to the left of the pencil (age) indicate areas where child needs practice. Any items on or to the right of the pencil (age) indicate areas where the child is showing developmentally appropriate progress.

Script for *Not Yet Demonstrating* Assessment Scores:

- ❖ "These scores indicate that your child is not yet demonstrating this skill. One reason for this may be lack of exposure to this specific skill. This result would suggest that your child could benefit from specific practice in this targeted area.
