



JOBS AVAILABLE THROUGH FLORIDA BACK TO WORK

This is an opportunity for you or someone you know who has been displaced from their job to receive local help. The Early Learning Coalition of Northwest Florida is proud to support these efforts in assisting our citizens with a means of providing for their families.

If you are looking for a job and have a dependent eighteen years old or under living in your household you may be able to find employment through the Florida Back to Work program.

The Chipola Regional Workforce Development Board had 91 employers in five counties sign up with job listings under the Florida Back to Work program. These employers are willing to hire individuals qualified for the program in a variety of jobs.

At the bottom of this sheet is a sliding scale income chart that shows how much an individual can make and be qualified for employment under this program. Income levels are determined using only the past thirty days of total family income.

Individuals determined qualified for the program are not guaranteed a job; however, those in the program will be given an opportunity to interview with employers for jobs open only to those qualified for Florida Back to Work. It will be up to the employer to make a job offer and the individual to accept. Wages will be paid by the employer and pay levels for the positions vary by employer and by the requirements of the position.

Positions openings range from entry level to those that require specialized skills. Some of the jobs in the program are short-term and others are considered permanent.
